Eagle Scout Scholarship

Larry Fleming passed away December 4, 2003 after a seven-month battle with cancer. He had served as president and chief executive officer of Knoxville Utilities Board since 1993. Larry was also widely recognized as one of the Knoxville community's most dynamic and dedicated leaders, generously pledging his time and talents to a host of worthy causes with a special emphasis on economic development and organizations that benefit children.

Larry served on the Covenant Health Board of Directors, was a board member of the Knoxville Area Chamber Partnership and the East Tennessee Economic Development Agency, among many other community organizations. He was instrumental in developing the Jobs Now! campaign to create 35,000 East Tennessee jobs. In Scouting, Larry served as council president from 1995-1996 and has been instrumental in leadership of the council golf tournament, Friends of Scouting, and the capital campaign to build our current Scout service center.

The Larry A. Fleming Memorial Eagle Scout Scholarship is available to Eagle Scouts who have completed their Eagle service project between January 1st and Dec. 31st, annually. One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a member of each yearly class of Eagle Scouts, based on the merit of the applicant's Eagle Scout service project. Candidates must apply for consideration by January 31, following the calendar year that they receive their Eagle Scout Award. An applicant does not have to be a graduating senior to qualify. The scholarship will be paid in the recipient's name, to a school of higher education, upon enrollment after his high school graduation.

Candidates must apply for consideration by January 31, following the calendar year that they receive their Eagle Scout Award. An applicant does not have to be a graduating senior to qualify. The scholarship winner will be announced at the Annual Eagle Scout Recognition Banquet. The scholarship will be paid in the recipient's name, to a school of higher education, upon enrollment after his high school graduation.
