

**TOQUA DISTRICT WEBELOS-REE 2018
LOUDOUN'S HEROES**

AN OFFICIAL TROOP VISIT EVENT

Held in Conjunction with the 2018 Toqua District Boy Scout Camporee

RULES AND INFORMATION

This unique event is open to rising Webelos (current 3rd grade Scouts – i.e., 2017-18 Bears), rising Arrow-of-Light Scouts (current 4th grade Scouts – i.e., 2017-18 Webelos), and any current Arrow-of-Light Scouts (current 5th grade Scouts) who have not yet crossed over to a Boy Scout Troop.

Onsite check-in Friday, May 4, from 6:00 - 7:00 pm, or Saturday, May 5, from 7:30 - 8:00 am, with the event opening and kickoff at 8:45 am. Scouts are asked to arrive and set up Friday to get the most out of this experience (see below). Event ends at 11:00 am Sunday, May 6.

Completed BSA Medical Forms Parts A and B MUST be provided for EVERY attendee at this event; Scouts and Adults. Forms are to be turned in at the onsite check-in for the event.

Food for Friday evening snack, all three Saturday meals, and Sunday breakfast will be provided. All Scouts are expected to help cook and clean up. Please let event organizers know of any severe food allergies.

Sunday, May 6:

7:00 am	Breakfast (Danishes and fruit), cleanup

11:00 am	Break camp, clean up, and check out

CAMPING:

Current Webelos and Arrow of-Light Scouts (current 4th and 5th graders) are allowed to camp as a Webelos Den with a ratio of one adult per four Scouts, but to maintain two-deep adult leadership; one of those adults must be a registered Scout leader. Current Bear Scouts must provide one parent/guardian per Scout.

Camping will be in tents with no camping shelters or tents provided by the event organizers. Each Pack and/or Scout family is responsible for providing the necessary tents for their Scouts and Adults. All BSA Youth Protection rules must be followed at all times during this event. No adult may share a tent with the opposite sex unless he or she is that adult's spouse. No youth may share a tent with an adult or a person of the opposite sex other than a family member or guardian. Assigning youth members more than two years apart in age to sleep in the same tent should be avoided unless the youth are relatives.

It is highly encouraged that Scouts tent with other Scouts and Adults tent separately, although this is not a requirement. Remember the purpose of this event is to give the Scouts a taste of being Boy Scouts.

OTHER RULES:

Fixed blade/sheath knives are prohibited.

No electronic devices (phones, radios, tablets, iPods and MP3 players, electronic games or other electronic devices) for youth. Adults should limit the use of their phones/tablets in the presence of youth except to take pictures.

The buddy system is to be used at all times.

We will have a port-a-john near the campsite. Playing in and around the port-a-john is not allowed.

ACCESSIBILITY AND SPECIAL NEEDS:

Camporee and Fort Loudoun State Park have no way to move the physically disabled around camp on a routine basis. While we invite and encourage you to join us, you must make arrangements to bring your own rough-terrain wheelchair or disability-specific Electric Powered Assisted Mobility Device (EPAMD) to this event if you need it. Even with such a device some areas may still be inaccessible. Charging of such devices may not be convenient to the camping area.

CPAP or other medically-necessary devices should be able to operate on a rechargeable energy source.
