Who is invited?

What do we bring?

What not to bring.

Alcoholic beverages - Alcoholic beverages are not permitted at any Scout camp out or activity. Personal archery equipment or firearms - We provide age appropriate shooting sports equipment. Sheath knives or weapons - Pocket knives are permitted but must fold and lock and if used by a Scout the Scout must have their Whittlin' Chip. Fireworks - Fireworks are not permitted.

What is the cost?

Regular Fee: \$10.00 per Cub Scout

Adults/siblings: \$8.00 per person.

Walk on Fee \$5.00 additional

What do we eat?

Cooking on your own. This is a great opportunity for your Scouts to complete requirements such as Webelos requirement Cast Iron Chef. Get with your Pack to find out if you will cook as a Pack or as individual families.

Facilities

Field of Dreams has several areas for tent camping. The camp has bathroom for Scouts/siblings and Adults. facilities. Make sure that all Scouts follow the buddy system and that a parent is with each Scout. Parents are responsible for their children not your Pack leaders.

Campfires

Field of Dreams does not allow on the ground campfires. Portable above ground fire pits may be used. All fire pits are the responsibility of the camp site.

Camp sites using a fire pit will:

- clear brush, leaves, and pine needles at least 5 feet back from the fire pit
- keep a bucket of water available at all times
- not leave the fire unattended
