

THE FUN STUFF!

- How can we make something FUN?
 - Learning the Outdoor Code?
 - Have them sing it to a tune they make up!
 - Learning the Scout Law?
 - Play catch with a bean bag
 - Learning to dress for the weather (for an outing or hike)?
 - Act it out in charades!
 - Learning to tie a knot?
 - Provide licorice "rope" and eat the knot if it is tied right!
 - Your ideas?

THE FUN STUFF!

- Crafts or other "make it" activities
- Make one ahead of time (or have your son/daughter make it)
- Have enough kits/supplies for everyone
 - Possible "surprise" guests or siblings... need extra?
- Have enough tools
- Have enough help/supervision
- If it needs to dry...?




