### Schedule:

1. Meet at 8:30 am at the rotunda - The ceremony will start at 9:00.
2. Presentation of Colors
3. Pledge of Allegiance
4. The meaning of Veteran's Day and Thank You to the Veterans in attendance.
5. Flag Placement

### Instructions on how to place flags:

- Family and friends of those interred will pick up flags first.
- Flag should be placed 12" in front of the marker.
- Use a tool to make a hole in the ground for the flag stick. If you try to shove it in the ground it will break!
- Flags will be provided and located at stations throughout the cemetery.
- Groups should start at the end of one row and complete that row before moving on to the next row.

### Guidelines:

- Scouts must be in Class A uniforms.
- All Scouts under 13 should be supervised by an adult.
- This event will occur rain or shine so be prepared.
- Please bring tools to aid in making a ¼ hole in the ground for the flag stick. (Example – A battery powered drill with a paddle bit or large Phillips Head Screwdriver with a rubber mallet hammer)
