
## Welcome New Brothers!



# Lodge Officer Election Procedures

At Fall Fellowship, we will have our yearly lodge officer elections to determine the officers for the 2025 term, which will start with the turn of the year.

The process by which we elect our officers is the same each year. Anyone is eligible to run for any office. You do not have to earn the right to run, but you must complete a few things before you can be voted on.

To be eligible to stand before the lodge, you have to have filled out the "Pellissippi Lodge Officer Petition" form and collect 20 signatures (25 for chief) of your peers (Arrowmen under the age of 21). Scan the QR code below for the form.

Once your petition is filled out, you will have an interview with the lodge advisor and finish collecting signatures. Then, and only then, are you completely eligible to stand before the lodge to be voted into your chosen office.



Upon time for the election, the order of voting will be Chief, Vice Chief of Administration, Vice Chief of Program, Secretary, and last but not least, Treasurer. Each chapter will have up to 10 votes based on the number of members present. In the event of a tie, the tie is broken by the sitting Lodge Chief.
