|   | <p>12: F-13 - In 2015 Pellissippi Lodge hosted the 100th Anniversary SR-6 Conclave at Camp Buck Toms. To commemorate the event, a series of flaps were produced. The design incorporated the arrowhead from the 1953 Conclave patch. The yellow border around the arrowhead signified the "Staff" issue. 550 of these were made. Included was a Totem pin that was reminiscent of the old Caldwell pins. These were made by Quality Lapel Pins. Only 100 of these Ordeal membership pins were made.</p> <p>In 2015 the lodge took pre-orders for 100th Anniversary Memorabilia packages. Included was a Pellissippi Lodge challenge coin. Also included in the design were the various Scouting program names to the flap since Scouts across all Scouts BSA programs were now eligible to participate in the Order of the Arrow. There were no restrictions regarding the purchasing of different honor level flaps. The Ordeal flaps were also given out to members who completed their Ordeal in 2019. 300 Ordeal flaps were made.</p> <p>S-151 The Brotherhood flaps were also given out to members who completed their Brotherhood in 2019. 200 Brotherhood flaps were made</p> <p>S-152 The Vigil flaps were also given out to members who completed their Vigil in 2019. 100 Vigil flaps were made.</p> | <p><b>\$30.00</b></p> |

|    | <p>21: R-10 At NOAC 2022 the lodge issued a special NOAC Service Round to all members who worked on the service corps for the conference. This “Delegate” flap set featured Ayres Hall on “the Hill.”</p> <p>S-175 &amp; X-34 The next patch set issued for the 2022 NOAC hosted by Pellissippi 230 was a two-piece “Service/Staff” set that featured the Torchbearer at Circle Park on the University of Tennessee campus.</p> <p>S-176 &amp; X-35 Additionally, an Orange Border “Trading” flap set featuring Neyland Stadium was also released with the official University of Tennessee Athletics Trademark.</p> <p>S-177 &amp; X-36 The last two-piece set issued for NOAC featured Basketball Legend Pat Summitt. |  | <p>25: P8 In 2022 Pellissippi Lodge hosted the National Conference at the University of Tennessee in Knoxville. To celebrate the hosting of the event, a large triangular jacket patch was issued featuring many famous landmarks of the University. Additionally, as a nod to a NOAC patch of the past, an Orange VW Bus was added to the patch. This patch was very popular among the members at the conference. Only 300 were made.</p>  | <p><b>\$15.00</b></p> |
|  | <p>26: S-178 Because of the popularity of the “Photo Flap” design, the lodge reordered the flap with an orange border and sold it to members who went to or served on staff at NOAC. This flap is exactly the same as the S-172 with the exception that it has an orange border. 300 were ordered for the first run of flaps, and then an additional run of 200 patches were ordered afterwards because of the designs popularity. It was sold to the lodge members and given to new Ordeal members that year. 500 patches came in the first run and a second run of 200 flaps were ordered that summer to be given to new Ordeal members at the 2022 Ordeal. |  | <p>30: S-180 In 2022 the Council held its annual Council Jamboree named “ScoutFest.” The theme for the event was “Saluting America’s Heroes.” Pellissippi Lodge provided a service corps to support ScoutFest and members of the Service Corps were allowed to earn this special flap. The price was \$8.00 per set, and a person could purchase five sets at the event. The one negative about the patch was the lodge totem was not present on the flap. The patches sold out at the event, which had over 280 people in attendance. 500 sets were made.</p>   | <p><b>\$10.00</b></p> |
|   | <p>36: S-85 - In 2002 the lodge was directed to change patch manufacturers by the Scout executive. Most of the lodge's previous flaps had been produced by the Krelman Company. This new policy led to the lodge using BSA National Supply as its patch manufacturer. The first flap produced under this policy was a new service flap. This design, however, was different than the original service flap. The fox head looked more like a rat or weasel than a fox. This flap was not well received by most lodge members and began a long-standing dislike of BSA National Supply. 500 were made.</p> | <p><b>\$5.00</b></p>  |
|  | <p>37: S-88 For the 60th Anniversary, a special issue service flap was unveiled. This flap was very popular with the lodge members. These were sold at all the events for the year. Unfortunately, the lodge by this time had started to get away from the purpose of the service flap, and the service hour requirement was not observed. About 500 were made.</p>  | <p><b>\$5.00</b></p>  |
|  | <p>38: J-1 - Among the other patches made, the lodge decided to issue an R-1 backpatch. The only difference would be that 50th Anniversary would be embroidered on it. However, a mistake was made on behalf of the manufacturer, and gray thread was used in the background of the patch. These were quickly sold so that the lodge could correctly reorder the desired patch. About 200 were made.</p>   | <p><b>\$10.00</b></p> |

|    | <p>40: S-41 - This patch was issued in 1993 during the lodge's 50th Anniversary. The design was based on the original S-1 and S-2 issues. |   | <p>41: S-39 - As soon as the mistake in the S-38 was realized and the rest of them were sold, the lodge decided to reorder the flap and add in an FDL. Not only does the S-39 have an FDL, but also, the gold arrow is a lighter color. When they were received by the lodge, they were immediately used for the next ordeal and the rest of the year. About 600 were made.</p>  | <p><b>\$5.00</b></p> |
|  | <p>42: S-43 - This flap was also issued at the 1993 Fall Fellowship. The patch is significant because it is the first flap in the lodge's history to not have a fox on it. The lodge activity patch for the event was the bottom piece for the flap. However, more flaps were created than activity patches, making the patch and the bottom not a true two-piece set. |  | <p>43: S-156 In addition to the standard issue ScoutFest 2019 flap that was available for members to purchase, a special Service Corps flap was also issued and given to members who served in the Service Corps. Members were given only one, and the flaps were paid for by the Council as a thank-you to the members who helped make ScoutFest 2019 a success. |    | <p>51: S-97 In 2006 the lodge issued a new service flap. It was decided by the lodge executive committee to revive the service hour requirement, and these could be earned by performing six hours of service. |  | <p>52: S-165 &amp; X-32 In 2021 the Council began construction on a new dining hall at Camp Buck Toms. To recognize this, the lodge issued a Spring Fellowship flap set that showcased the construction and a D10 bulldozer, a slight homage to former Council President, Vigil Honor, and Caterpillar dealership owner, Wes Stowers. The set was very well received, and only 200 sets were made.</p> | <p><b>\$10.00</b></p> |
|  | <p>53: S-147 &amp; X-27 The 2019 Winter Banquet marked the first time a two-piece set was issued for the Winter Banquet patch. The Sash which incorporates the Tennessee Orange color in the body of the sash served as a parody of the Order of the Arrow sash by replacing the Brotherhood bars at the ends of the sash with the shape of the state of Tennessee. Additionally, the Vigil triangle traditionally located in the center of the sash was replaced with a Tri-Star logo which represented the State of Tennessee logo from the state flag. These sashes proved to be an incredibly popular memorabilia item and sold out within their first month of availability. The sashes were produced by Shelby Patch Company and created some controversy after their production but nonetheless, Pellissippi Lodge received significant attention from their production at both local and regional events throughout the year. 350 sashes were made.</p> | <p><b>\$25.00</b></p> |
