October 24 - 26, 2025 (Rain or Shine) at Monroe County Airport, 350 Airport Rd in Madisonville, TN.

Registration

Online at www.eastTNscouts.org/sf ~ Now - Sept 22 = \$27. Sept 23 - Oct 17 = \$37. Oct 18- 25 = \$47
Children 4 & under are free. Everyone must have a copy of their Health Form Parts A & B.

Pre Check-In

This year, your unit will be able to check in at the office on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of ScoutFest week. You will get patches, wristbands, schedules & maps, and your campsite assignment. This will allow you to proceed directly to your campsite once you arrive on-site. Friday night check-in will be off-site, and Saturday participants will check in on-site.

Camping

Sites assigned will be pre-assigned by registration count. Cub Scouts camp as families with their pack; other unit types camp by unit. Fires/charcoal in elevated pits only. There is no electricity on site. Bring water jugs – there will be water buffaloes on site.

Food & Vendors

No meals are provided as part of the event fee. Your unit should coordinate meals. Food trucks will be available for Friday dinner and Saturday lunch/dinner. ScoutFest Trading Post & GSMC Scout Shop on site. The event t-shirt pre-order deadline is October 4.

Activities

Rock climbing, zipline, inflatables, STEM zone, crafts, rocket launches, gaga ball, military displays, conservation projects, and so much more. Some activities have age/rank limits. As the list grows, we will update the website and the *Ultimate Guide*.

Health & Safety

Medical HQ on-site, first responders. Accessible port-a-potties are available; please bring mobility aids if needed. A 'Calming Corner' tent for sensory breaks will also be available.

Key Rules

No bikes/scooters/skateboards. No smoking/alcohol. No animals except service animals. Follow all Youth Protection/Safeguarding Youth rules. Quiet time 11 PM. Leave No Trace. Runway is off-limits.

Check-In & Departure

Arrive on Friday from 4:00 PM to 10:00 PM or Saturday from 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM. Carpool if possible. Check out with your subcamp's staff before leaving.
