



## COUNCIL BOATSWAIN APPLICATION

December 2025

Dear Sea Scouts and Skippers:

The Great Smoky Mountain Council invites applications for eligible Sea Scouts to serve as the Council Boatswain for our council Sea Scout Quarterdeck for a one-year term beginning February 1, 2026.

The Quarterdeck's purpose is to provide support and guidance to maintain and grow the Sea Scouting in our Council. The Quarterdeck is a youth-led union of our Sea Scout Ships, supported by adult Scouters, that organizes events, provides training, and leads forums to support Sea Scouting across our council.

The title of Boatswain dates to 10th-century England, where they were the chief standing officer on deck, in charge of maintenance, rigging, cordage, anchorage, sails, flags, cargo, and all other aspects of the ship's stores. In modern times, a ship's bosun's duties are similar, with them serving as the foreman to the deck crew, performing frequent inspections as to the well-being of the vessel, as well as guiding programs to ensure its well-being. The duties of our Council Boatswain are the same, but instead of being responsible for a Ship's company, their crew is instead the Ships themselves. A growth mindset is imperative to success, not just seeking growth in units, but also in what programs those Ships can provide.

All nominees must be registered with Scouting America as a member in a Ship within the Council for the entire duration of their term and be under 21 for the entirety of the term. Nominees must be positive representatives of Sea Scouts within their community. Self-nominations will be accepted.

Boatswain applicants must (1) have held or currently hold a position of responsibility at the unit, district, council, territory, or national level and (2) submit a completed nomination form on or before **January 15, 2026**. The selected candidate will be notified and announced by January 29, 2026. Boatswain nominees who are not selected will have the opportunity to be considered for a Boatswain's Mate position.
